## Why we need toiletry donations

Baby Bank Network Bristol gives out **over 1,000 toiletry packs for mums and babies each year**. Since the organisation began in 2015 we have given out **over 7,900 toiletry packs!**

**4.2 million people in the UK live in hygiene poverty\*** - this means not being able to afford many of the everyday hygiene and personal grooming products most of us take for granted, like shampoo, maternity pads, nappies or toothpaste. 65% of parents affected by hygiene poverty have had to choose between buying hygiene products for themselves or their children.\*

Each year **we spend over £8,000 on toiletries** to supplement those that are donated by supporters. Most of the families we support receive toiletries as part of their bundle.

As part of our annual Santa's Sack Christmas Appeal we ask businesses, organisations, school, faith and community groups to donate toiletries. This helps to keep our shelves stocked and reduces the amount we need to spend on toiletries during the year.

## How to donate toiletries

There are **three ways to donate toiletries** to Baby Bank Network Bristol this Christmas.

### Organise a Toiletries Drive



**Organise a toiletries drive in your place of work or worship, school, nursery or other community venue.** Here's a few tips on how to organise it:

1. **Check** with the relevant person that you can host a toiletries drive in the venue and where you can set it up safely.
2. **Check what toiletries we need** donated - see page 3 or visit [our website](#).
3. **Set-up your collection point** - use a Christmas sack, a box or something else!
4. **Print signs** and put them on/by your collection point - [download our Christmas appeal posters](#). Use Christmas decorations to help people notice it!
5. Make sure your signs clearly state; what to donate, where to leave donations, a date to donate by.
6. **Communicate** with everyone in the building, school, company so they know what to do and when! Try e-mails, social media, posters, and sharing at meetings, in newsletters and on your website/intranet.
7. **Remind people** to donate, and **share your successes** during and after the appeal.
8. **Book a delivery slot** to bring your items to our warehouse or request a collection.
9. Gather your donations and **bring them to our warehouse by Friday 19<sup>th</sup> December** (or when we re-open from 5<sup>th</sup> January).
10. **Thank everyone who donated** - we can say thank you on our social media (please get in touch to organise), and we will send you a thank you letter in January.

## **Donate pre-made toiletry packs**

We give out toiletry packs with most of the bundles for families. It is very helpful if they are ready to go on our shelves. **If you are able to make ready-made packs, we would be really grateful.**

If you would like to donate more than 50 packs, please get in touch so that we can organise storing them.

**Please include the following in each pack:**

### **Baby toiletry pack:**

- 1 x pack baby wipes
- Approx. 100 nappy sacks
- 1 x pot/tube of nappy cream
- 1 x bottle of baby wash/baby bubble bath
- 1 x bottle baby shampoo
- 1 x pack of cotton wool
- 1 x flannel or sponge
- 1 x baby toothbrush and toothpaste

### **Mum toiletry pack:**

- Maternity pads – 2 packs
- Breast pads – 1 pack/box.
- 1 x toothbrush and 1 toothpaste
- 1 x bottle of shampoo
- 1 x bottle shower gel
- 1 x bar soap

### **Optional extras:**

- 1 x baby towel
- 1 x grooming set - brush/comb & nail scissors/clippers
- 1 x baby lotion/oil
- Nappies size 1 (no size 3 nappies please)

### **Optional extras:**

- A few treats to make a new mum feel a bit more special e.g. hand cream, lip balm, bubble bath, body lotion, stretch mark cream etc
- 1 x bottle of conditioner

**Please do not donate any of the following as we cannot give them to families:**

- **Wrapped gifts/donations or cards** - we will have to unwrap items to check them and remove cards before giving them to families.
- Any **medication or medicated items** (e.g. pregnancy vitamins, gripe water or eczema shampoo).
- **Make-up, talcum powder and tampons.**

## **Donate toiletries online**

Buy and donate toiletries (or vouchers we can use at a later date to buy toiletries) via our [For Common Good wishlist](#). Items we need will be delivered to our warehouse in bulk when we need them, and without a delivery cost.
